A LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



Dear Friends,

It is a great privilege to present the Annual Report representing July 1, 2022, to June 30, 2023. Michael's Place has been built on the trust of the families we serve and the donors and volunteers who support our mission. We are dedicated to helping those grieving while being good and faithful stewards of the financial support we receive.

Michael's Place works to mitigate the many adverse effects of grief by building communities and opportunities for support. This year, we welcomed over 200 new program participants and reached beyond our northern Michigan region to serve over 3000* individuals, schools, businesses, and communities across 14 counties.

The new fiscal year will provide increased outreach and programming for the bereaved. The Grand Traverse County Commissioners unanimously selected Michael's Place to receive \$325,000 from the American Rescue Fund Act (ARPA). The ARPA funds will bridge the gaps in services for grieving children and adults. I look forward to all of the possibilities this funding provides and sharing its impact next year.

We are grateful to the generous benefactors who financially invest in Michael's Place with one-time gifts, multi-year pledged gifts, and planned gifts written into wills or trusts. Each method of giving is essential to Michael's Place and helps us continue to provide no-cost grief support. Michael's Place offers grief support services designed to ease the impact of loss by providing a safe space to share experiences and connect with others, tools and resources to cope with the grief, and educational opportunities to help build a grief-informed, compassionate community to ease isolation and encourage a sense of hope for the bereaved.

PEER-FACILITATED SUPPORT GROUPS

Support groups are facilitated by trained volunteers and staff who provide guidance and peer-to-peer support. Youth meet in age-appropriate groups and participate in grief-related activities and discussions. Adults meet with others who have a greater understanding of their grief journey.

ROBIN'S NEST

Robin's Nest provides a reprieve from the loss and a sense of normalcy among peers. With the help of mentors, the Robin's Nest program provides best day activities and educational opportunities to help grieving children and their families find joy in their lives and create new memories.

SCHOOL-BASED INITIATIVE

Michael's Place provides support and guidance to the community through:

- > *In-school support groups to elementary, middle, and high school students grieving a death.*
- > *Guidance and training to schools to develop Bereavement Preparedness Plans, assistance following the death of a school community member, and ongoing grief education.*

COMPASSIONATE WORKPLACE

Michael's Place provides support and guidance to businesses and community organizations who have experienced a death and to professionals that work in high-loss environments.

COMMUNITY EDUCATION

In addition to the customized training available to schools, businesses, and healthcare professionals, Michael's Place offers educational presentations to community groups and organizations on grief-related topics.

A Year of *IMPACT*



In a recent survey of our families, our participants were asked if they felt safe and welcomed at Michael's Place. 100% of participants agreed, with 82% strongly agreeing. Additionally, 94% of participants report that they feel connected to peers within their support groups, helping offset the isolation that often comes with grief.

THE IMPACT OF CHILDHOOD BEREAVEMENT

Research shows that bereaved children are at an increased risk of disrupted development, that when unaddressed can lead to short- and long-term difficulties including decreased academic performance, reduced resilience and self esteem, and increased mental health concerns. A caring community, positive role models, healthy coping skills, and peer support are protective factors that help offset grief-related adversity.

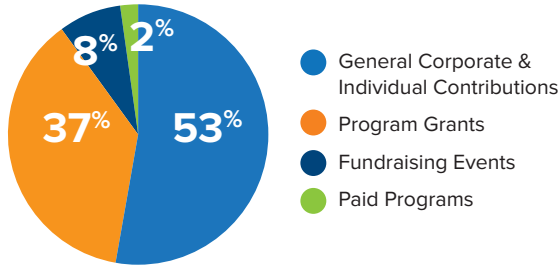

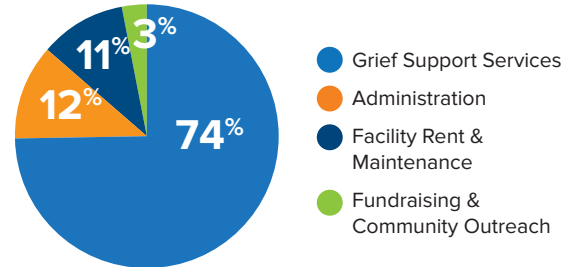
