LOSS BY SUICIDE SUPPORT GROUPS IN CADILLAC

CADILLAC, MI — A well-known Traverse City grief support center is providing services in the Cadillac area with grant support from the Cadillac Area Community Foundation.

Michael's Place, a nonprofit that offers support programs to ease the impact of loss, has established a Loss by Suicide support group at the First Presbyterian Church. The group meets the first and third Tuesday nights each month at 6:30 p.m.

"This group is run by a Michael's Place staff person along with trained peer facilitators from the Cadillac area who have also lost loved ones to suicide," said Melissa Fournier, Program Director for Michael's Place. "The group began in November, 2016, and so far the feedback from those attending has been overwhelmingly positive."

"We felt it was important to extend our services to Cadillac so that individuals are not suffering traumatic loss in isolation," Fournier said. "We are grateful to the Cadillac Area Community Foundation for helping us to make this program possible."
